Growing the Kingdom of God

The Executive Church Council continues to prayerfully discern God's plans for Snow Hill. Over the past year, we have used the principles of planting a garden to take steps as we grow the kingdom of God. Many of the ideas have been included in Pastor Keith's sermons over the past year.

As we "open back up" from the pandemic, look for <u>your place</u> to work the garden.

 Get off the porch! The farmer doesn't grow much just sitting on the porch to watch and see what happens. Each person brings specific gifts and talents. We need YOU!



2. We don't want to just eat tomatoes! It takes variety, a combination to make a harvest. Everyone will not like everything, but we want to be sure everyone has food to eat.

- 3. Plants (& people) have different needs. Some are established and come back year after year. Some are brand new or distressed and need a little extra loving care.
- 4. It takes intentional, hard



work with weeding (removing what should not be there), fertilizing,

water to have a good harvest.

- 5. Crops need to be rotated. programs need to be revamped and sometimes replaced. (Hey, you might need to sit somewhere different (2))
- 6. The SON makes the garden grow. We plant seeds, we work the plan, but God makes the seeds grow.
- 7. Harvest time is fun. We are called to gather together, share the bounty, have fun, and praise God for all He provides.
